The HUBZone Council will present the following awards at the 2010 HUBZone Council Annual Meeting & Conference:

- **HUBZone Employee of the Year Award** - recognizes an employee of a HUBZone-certified company who resides in a HUBZone area and has demonstrated success in improving the lives of him/herself, family, and/or community*
- **HUBZone Corporate Citizen of the Year Award** - recognizes a HUBZone-certified company that has made significant contributions to improve the economic, educational, and/or social quality of its community*
- **HUBZone Council Contractor of the Year Awards** - two awards recognize the HUBZone Council member companies that earned (a) the largest number of HUBZone contract awards and (b) the largest total HUBZone contract dollar volume during fiscal year 2009⁺



* These awards are available to all members of the HUBZone community. Current HUBZone certification is necessary but membership in the HUBZone Council is not required.

⁺ The winners of these awards must be HUBZone Council regular members in good standing and will be determined by official federal government reporting data.
